Ambolirano



Pastor Martin and his family settled in Ambolirano. They are happy to take possession of the house we built. The project begins to take shape. This place will become our base and a place of training. Jesus told us "Go and make disciples of all nations". This is exactly what we are striving to do in Madagascar and more particularly on the Bemaraha plateau.

Since our last visit, the construction of the school has not changed much. It remains the roof to build. The worker specialized in the construction of the thatched roofs should arrive soon.

We gave slates, chalks and sponges to the village chief. He is responsible for distributing them to the children of the school.

The village has 140 people and a large part was at the rendez vous. Dr. Justin immediately began the auscultations. In the evening we spent the film "Minuscule". The villagers laughed heartily watching this animated film and we really enjoyed this moment of relaxation. The next morning, Denis shared the word of God with the villagers who were particularly attentive and receptive.

We are warmly welcomed by the people of this new village. After a beautiful biblical exhortation brought by Alain, we spoke with the village chief about their current needs.

They will build a "small dispensary" where Dr. Justin can practice his profession during our visits. Toilets should be built following Justin's teachings on hygiene.

At our next trip, we will bring school supplies for fifty children. The villagers are currently fetching water at 1 km from the village. They plan to dig a well close to homes.

Once the well will be dug, Andry will offer them, a water sanitation system that is easy to put in place and does not require complicated maintenance.

The chief proposes to make the school available, on Sunday, when a pastor will come to settle in the village.

We arrived at the end of the day, the time to set up the camp and organize the evening.

Pastor Cyrill had the young people of the village sing and dance. Denis then read and developed a biblical text and Andry translated.

Two young women from the village will come to Antananarivo to attend a Bible seminar at our friend Sedera's school. Pastor Cyrill will accompany them.

The evening was musical. For over an hour and a half, they listened and watched Malagasy Christian music videos.

The next day Andry installed a water filter. We also took water from where people get their supplies for testing.

We then left for Ambolirano to pay a short visit to Pastor Martin.

Back on Tana, encouraged by what we experienced, we can not wait to leave soon for a new adventure.
